Strategic planning committees are hard at work.

Exciting news: Dept of Ed ranked RPS in first place (one of 25) for 556 elementary schools doing PARCC in 2016. Plans to continue professional development, including Everyday Math workshop from University of Pennsylvania.

New bike rack in place. New tables ordered for playground will provide seating for parents.

Graduation date survey was sent out. Awaiting responses.

Choice lottery complete December 1; 8 students on the waiting list. Receiving 3 additional spots from State for next year to accommodate siblings who were carried as unfunded students this year.

The Board Secretary report was submitted and approved. Encumbrances are in place. All accounts are within budget.

Annual Financial Audit received. Auditor will present at next meeting on January 5.
