PUPIL HEALTH POLICY AND PROCEDURES

**Parents/Guardians or Emergency Contacts
Will be contacted if a child exhibits
Any one of the following conditions:**

KEEP YOUR CHILD HOME UNTIL:

1. Diarrhea
- severe

Child is symptom free for 24 hours

2. Vomiting

Child is symptom free for 24 hours

3. Fever
- 100% or above

Child must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medications.

4. Cold and one or more of the following:
- persistent sneezing and/or coughing, sore throat
- yellow/green mucous discharge from nose
- loss of appetite

5. Persistent or severe coughing
- child makes high-pitched croupy sound after coughing

6. Unusual behavior
- child is cranky or sleepy
- child feels general discomfort or just seems ill

7. Open draining wound or weeping/bleeding untreated skin lesions

Infected Patches of Skin

*A doctor's note is required for readmission to school

- crusty, bright yellow, dry or moist areas of skin

Pink Eye:

* A doctor's note is required for readmission to school

- tears, redness, irritation of the eye followed by swelling and discharge of pus

Ringworm, Head Lice:

*Treatment must be given before able to return to school.

PLEASE NOTE: Parents/Guardians must make arrangements to pick up their child when the child exhibits one or more of the above-stated conditions. Any child who is absent must bring a note upon return to school explaining the reason for the absence. **A note from the doctor is required for any absence of three (3) days or longer.**
